EM301 - Triple-pole emergency door release

Product Description

The range of emergency door releases (EDR) from CDVI provide a physical method of releasing an electronic lock in the event of an emergency.

These are generally fitted where there is no manual method to permanently remove power from a fail safe lock allowing the door to be permanently unlocked in an emergency.

The EM301 range are both resettable. Pressing the front plate will cause the plate to drop, operating the microswitch. The plate will remain dropped until reset with the reset key.


The EM301-LS includes visual indication and sounder.


